#### Problems

- Insufficient Consonants
  - Reappropriate existing shapes ង
  - Add new shapes
  - Mark existing shapes
  - Add new sequences อว
- Applies also to:
  - Vowels
  - Tones

#### Factors

- Linguistics
  - How do we make the language fit?
  - How do we handle loan words?
- Literacy
  - What is simple to read?
    - One sound per letter
    - Keep It Simple Stupid
  - What do people already know?
    - Thai in school

#### Factors

- Sociolinguistics
  - Do they want something to make them unique?
  - Will they accept reappropriation of letters?
    - Changing the associated sound of a letter
  - What does the government think?

### Approaches Taken for Thai Script

- Reappropriation
  - Mai tai khu as a vowel
    - แต็ง to spread (Bru)
  - Mai trii as a vowel
  - Nikhahit
    - มู่ย (Northern Khmer)

# Approaches Taken for Thai Script

- Reappropriation (concl)
  - Mai Karan as a tone
    - ลิ๊ว already (Mien)
  - Phinthu
    - โทร So language (So)

## Approaches Taken for Thai Script

- New Sequences
  - Tone marks everywhere!
    - กั๋วะ country (Mien has 6 written tones)
- Wild Ideas
  - Underlining (aargh!)
    - ฐง snake (Omkoi Pwo Karen)

### Non Approaches in Thai

- Extra levels
  - Upper diacritics, still 2 levels
  - Lower diacritics, still 1 level
- Only 2 upper diacritics change
  - Mai tai khu: vowel or tone
  - Mai trii: vowel or tone
